- Pony behavior is for daily homework and silent reading. **c= complete, i= partially complete, n= not complete**
- Students receiving 1's **MUST** retake assessments. Students receiving 2's will be asked to retake them. Students must fill out a retake reflection plan before the retake.
- Late work receives no penalty on a standard but can lower your Pony behavior score.
