Step 1: Parent/Guardian Section

As the parent/guardian, my signature indicates I have read and understand Monticello School District Board Policy 7540.03 Student Technology Acceptable Use and Agreement, and give permission for my child to access the described network resources under the terms of the policy.

If a Chromebook is damaged, a fee of up to twenty dollars (\$20) will be charged to the student for the repair and must be paid before the Chromebook is returned. **However, if a touch screen is damaged, a fee of up to one hundred dollars (\$100) will be charged to the student. If the damage is deemed intentional, the student could be charged for the full replacement of the Chromebook.** It is the responsibility of the student and/or parents to bring the Chromebook for repair in a timely manner. If multiple parts are damaged, multiple charges may be assessed but no more than twenty dollars (\$20) per part fixed or replaced (excluding broken touch screens or intentional damages - see above). Chromebooks are property of the district. Repairs can only be done by our technology staff or sent offsite at the discretion of the Technology Services Coordinator.
