The Monticello Board of Education recognizes that the public is entitled to the fullest and most complete information regarding the affairs of the Board as is compatible with the conduct of Board affairs and the transaction of the Board business.

The Board designates the district administrator as the person responsible to properly notice all meetings of the Board and Board committees consistent with the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law.

Meeting notifications and agendas shall be provided via email to the District's official newspaper; other local media outlets; the Village of Monticello; the presidents of both the Monticello Educational Association and the Monticello Educational Support Staff Association; and other organizations and individuals requesting such notification.

Agendas shall be physically posted at locations designated by the district administrator.
